

# Securing your collector car or motorcycle

for spring and severe weather season.

Here are a few simple ways to protect your prized possession.



**Bring it inside!** Store your collector vehicle in a garage or shed with **reinforced, fireproofed walls** and a **bolted, well-anchored roof**.

Make sure you **have the roof inspected annually for damage**.



**Trim back or cut down** large, dead and dying trees and branches if they overhang your storage space.



**Relocate your vehicle** in advance of a storm. Some policies have provisions that will pay for proactive relocation.

**Install a lightning rod** on your vehicle storage space's roof and make sure it is properly grounded.



**Change out smoke detector batteries** every 6 months.

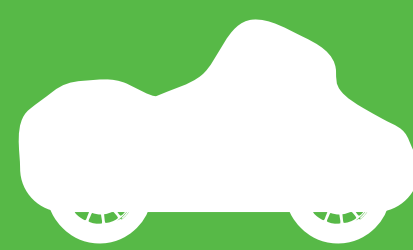
Install a **security system with remote fire monitoring**.

It's expensive, but installing automatic sprinklers or a **fire suppression system** could save you a lot of heartache later.

**Never leave oily rags or other fire hazards** laying out in your garage or shed. Get rid of them immediately after use.



**Flood damage is not typically covered** under standard CV or motorcycle policies. You will likely need a flood policy for this coverage.



**Cover your vehicle** to prevent sun, rain and wind abrasion damage to the finish and keep the upholstery looking factory-fresh.
